## $10^{\text {th }}$ Masters' International SPRINT GAMES Moscow, Russia, 3-4 March, 2018

The competition will be held in accordance with the Constitutions and Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) and the International Skating Union (ISU). The competition takes place at the covered 400 m standard track of Sports Complex "Krylatskoye" (Moscow) on artificial ice. This competition is an event on the International Masters’ Calendar 2017/2018 of the IMSSC and the International Calendar 2017/2018 of the ISU.

## 1. Competitions \& Eligibility

The competition will take place on 3 and 4 March 2018
Ladies and Men: Age groups from 30 (Masters)
$500 \mathrm{~m}, 1.000 \mathrm{~m}\left(1^{\text {st }}\right.$ day $) / 500 \mathrm{~m}, 1.000 \mathrm{~m}\left(2^{\text {nd }}\right.$ day $)$
Four distances competition. To be eligible the skater must be a member of a National Speed Skating Federation recognized by the ISU and must have a license of his/her federation.

## 2. Age Groups

The competitions take place in five year age groups as follows:

## 3. Limit Times

According to IMSSC Rule 3.1.6, every participant has to inform the national IMSSC Member of his (her) most recent time on the 500 m . It is the responsibility of the IMSSC Member to accept the times. If the applicable time ( 500 m for the Sprint Games) does not meet the Maximum Time as laid down in Rule 3.1.7 (Maximum Time Table - see below) the participant cannot take part in the Sprint Games unless the national IMSSC Member decides otherwise in a written consent.

## 4. Schedule

### 4.1. Training Times

### 4.2. Drawing

Friday, 2 Mar 2018, 14:30-17:00 in the Sports Complex "Krylatskoye".
On the first two distances, before drawing, skaters shall be seeded in three groups, according to their best times of the current season, their best times of last season or their estimated times. The seeding occurs per age group or per joined age groups. Drawing shall be done according to ISU Rule 242,paragraphs 2 and 3, with the exception that all competitors will be admitted in the last distance. If more than 100 participants are competing, they shall be divided into two or more blocks of five-year age groups. The first block completes its two distances before next block, and so on. This will reduce waiting time between the two distances.

Generally the age groups are drawn separately. If the number of competitors is very small in one or several of the five year age groups, neighbored 5 year age groups may be joined for drawing and speedskating. But the allotting of track on the third distance is decided by the ranking after two distances for each 5 year age group, and not by the ranking in the joined, neighbored groups. The final distance drawing and classification must be done in her/his own age group independent of the number of participants in that age group.

A skater who completes all distances successfully and obtains the lowest total of points in his/her five-year age group wins the four-distance competition in that group.

## 5. Limitation of participants

No limitation or quota is foreseen by the OC. The OC is willing to host the event for up to 250 skaters. In the unlikely event of exceeding of that number OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants depending on the registration order.

## 6. Prizes

All competitors, who succeed the four distances contest, obtain a medal and souvenir. For the 4 distance combination the first three competitors of a five year age group will be awarded a prize. All participants who skate successfully the competition without disqualification, obtain a certificate and a protocol with the results (only end times, no lap times).
